Decontamination/Disinfecting Instructions for Centrifuges

- Unplug the centrifuge before disinfecting.
- Use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Apply disinfecting solution with a towel or cloth. Do not submerge the machine in water or other cleaning solutions as this will cause damage to the unit.
- **ONLY isopropyl alcohol or a 10% (5500 PPM) bleach solution should be used to disinfect the centrifuge and its accessories. Wipe off thoroughly after use to prevent damage to the units.**
- All surfaces must be dried immediately after disinfecting.
- **TBQ GERMICIDAL PRODUCTS ARE NOT RECOMMENDED AS THEY MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE CENTRIFUGE AND VOID THE WARRANTY.**
- Fully/partially halogenated hydrocarbons, ketones, esters, ethers, benzyls, ethyl benzenes, and all other chemicals not prescribed by the manufacturer should not be used as they may cause damage to the rotor chamber, rotor, tube holder, accessories, and centrifuge exterior.
- **Failure to decontaminate the centrifuge and/or provide the Certificate of Decontamination will result in a \$50.00 fee.**

Shipping Instructions

- Place the machine inside a box with bubble wrap/packing peanuts.
- Display the RGA # provided to you on the outside of the box.
